



Ottawa International Soccer Club Coaching Code of Conduct – Players

All players who register to play with the Ottawa International Soccer Club agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct. Failure to adhere to this code may result in suspension, dismissal from the team and or dismissal from the club.

As a registered player with the OISC I will:

1. Respect my coach, team mates and team officials at all times.
2. Play according to the laws and spirit of the game.
3. Be on time and be prepared for games and practices.
4. Display self-control in all situations.
5. Not use foul or abusive language - before, during or after a game or practice.
6. Train and play to the best of your ability, have a positive attitude, and encourage others to do the same.
7. Respect the opposition regardless of how they treat you.
8. Respect the referee and never dispute his or her decisions.
9. Turn up for practices and matches in appropriate and clean clothing.
10. Be humble when we win.
11. Be graceful when we lose.
12. Be fair always, no matter what the cost.
13. Work for the good of my team.
14. Believe in the honesty of my opponents.
15. Conduct myself with honour and dignity.
16. Applaud the efforts of my teammates and my opponents.
17. Not use electronic media such as mass emails, websites, Facebook, tweeter, etc. or any other form of communication to publicly embarrass the OISC, my coach, my team, the referee or club officials.

These Codes of Conduct have been approved by the Ottawa Internationals Soccer Club. Any violation of these codes may be grounds for suspension or expulsion from a team or the club.
